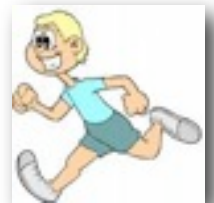
Summer Day Camp/Activities

This will be partially subsidized by events and sponsorships over the next three years. (* Todays prices)



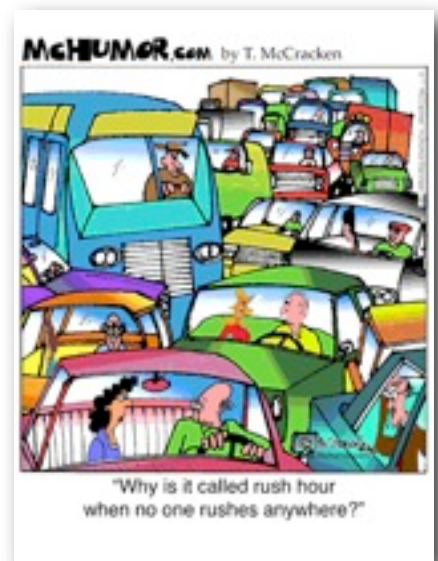


We have submitted an application form to The Guinness World Records. To attempt a Swimathon over a 24 hour period to break or set a world distance record for club swimming.
